Financial conditions:

- participation fee (participation in the work of conference, publication of brief outline of report, cultural programme, dinners) – 150 UAH (12 USD); enter the fee during registration;
- publication fee – 30 UAH per page;
- other expenses (transit, accommodation, breakfasts) are paid by the participants themselves.

Brief outline of report requirements:

- materials (not more than 1 page) are submitted on a disk in Word 6.0 or 7.0 format followed by two paper copies; they also should be send to the e-mail address of the subdepartment;
- in separate files you submit:
 1. author information (last name, first name, patronymic, educational degree, academic rank, position held, place of work, home address with zip code, telephone number, e-mail address; e.g., ivanova_vid.doc);
 2. brief outline of report, file named after last name of an author, e.g., ivanova.doc.
- name of publication is placed in the center of the top line (black type size 14), underneath name of the author and name of the city in parentheses;
- text of report should be printed with Times New Roman with 1,5 spaces, point size 14, left, up and down space 2,5 cm, right space 1 cm. Dash and hyphen should be clearly defined.
- If you use special signs or prints, they should be submitted in a separate file;

- Demonstrative material should be in italics, meaning of words should be high lined by double quotes;

Brief outline of report that does not follow the requirements listed above and materials sent later than the required date will not be taken into consideration!

Publication of brief outline of report for PhD holders is free of charge
